#### Leadership

- Helped launch, lead, and strategize for international athlete advocacy organization working to address the balance of power between athletes and sport administrators
- Edit media statements and speak on behalf of athletes regarding key issues
- Key issues: Athlete political speech at the Olympic Games; Authoritarian regimes' use of Olympics to enhance legitimacy and distract from violations of human rights; Unequal distribution of revenue in the Olympic Movement; Lack of independence of both the World Anti-Doping Agency and the Court of Arbitration for Sport from the International Olympic Committee; Athlete abuse and persecution in Iran, Belarus, Afghanistan, and China
